Louisa May EGERTON states,

- 1. I am a Plain Clothes Senior Constable of Police currently stationed at the Townsville Criminal Investigation Branch.
- I can recall certain events which occurred on Monday the 14th of February 2005. On that
 date, I was rostered to perform duties at the Mundingburra Criminal Investigation
 Branch in the company of Detective Sgt Gary CAMPBELL and Plain Clothes Constable
 Robert ENCHONG.
- I can recall that on that morning, I accompanied Detective Campbell to the Townsville Magistrates Court and was present during conversations with his honour Mr Glasgow.
- 4. Later that morning, Detective CAMPBELL handed me a 'Data Trans' dive computer. The exhibit tag attached to this item was A837197.

- 5. At 5:00pm, I attended the Hyperbaric Medicine Unit at the Townsville General Hospital in the company of Plain Clothes Constable ENCHONG. I took Exhibit A837197 with me to the Hospital. I spoke with Doctor David GRIFITHS and technician, Steven DUNSCOMBE. (Discussions held regarding what examinations were to be conducted upon the dive computer. Advised that they had been instructed by Detective Campbell as to what was required.)
- 6. I observed whilst ENCHONG activated a video recording of this examination of the dive computer conducted by Doctor Griffiths.
- 7. I was present whilst the dive computer was activated and placed in water in hyperbaric chamber to distance of 5 metres. At 1 metre depth, gas alarm activated causing a continuous steady beep down to 5 metres then back up to 1 metre where it stopped. The computer's batter was then turned around and put in backwards. No LCD screen detail observed when turned on. The unit was again placed in water in hyperbaric chamber and taken to 5 metres depth. At no time did any activation of the computer commence either with information on the screen or audio alert such as a beep or other. Then taken out of chamber and changed battery again where it was activated again and commenced working in normal order.
- 8. At the conclusion of the test, I took possession of the computer and returned it to the Townsville Property Point at Mundingburra Police Station, lodging it into the secure drop safe.
- 9. The video recording of the testing procedure was also lodged as exhibit Number A1029295.
