Robert ENCHONG states,

- 1. I am a Plain Clothes Constable of Police currently stationed at the Deeragun Criminal Investigation Branch.
- 2. On Monday the 14th of February 2005 I was rostered an 8a-4p shift with Plain Clothes Senior Constable Louisa EGERTON. On that date, I was stationed at the Mundingburra Criminal Investigation Branch.
- 3. At 5:00pm EGERTON and I attended the Hyperbaric Medicine Unit at the Townsville General Hospital. At the time I was aware that EGERTON was in possession of Exhibit A837197 which was a 'Data Trans' dive computer. EGERTON had a conversation with Doctor David GRIFITHS and Steven DUNSCOMBE, a technician. (EGERTON, GRIFITHS and DUNSCOMBE discussed what examinations were to be conducted upon the dive computer.)
- 4. At the commencement of the examinations I activated a video recorder that I had in my possession. I recorded the examinations conducted by Dr GRIFFITHS on the dive computer at the Hyperbaric Unit.

5. I recorded the following events:

- i. Activation of the dive computer and placement into water to depth of 5 meters
- ii. At 1 meter depth, gas alarm has activated causing a continuous steady beep down to 5 meters
- iii. Taken back up to 1 meter where beeping stopped.
- iv. Computers battery turned around and put in backwards
- v. No LCD screen details observed when turned on.
- vi. Unit placed in water in hyperbaric chamber
- vii. Unit taken back to depth of 5 meters
- viii. No activation of computer screen or audio alert (beep or otherwise)
- ix. Unit removed from chamber and battery changed. Unit has activated again and commenced working.
- 6. At the completion of the examination I stopped the video tape.
- 7. EGERTON then obtained the Computer dive unit from Dr GRIFITHS and we returned to the Mundingburra Police Station where I lodged the video tape that I recorded as exhibit number A1029295.
- 8. I am now able to produce one video cassette tape of the examination conducted to the 'Data Trans' dive computer which tendered and marked exhibit number
- 9. EGERTON later spoke with Detective CAMPBELL. (EGERTON advised him of the results of the testing procedure)
